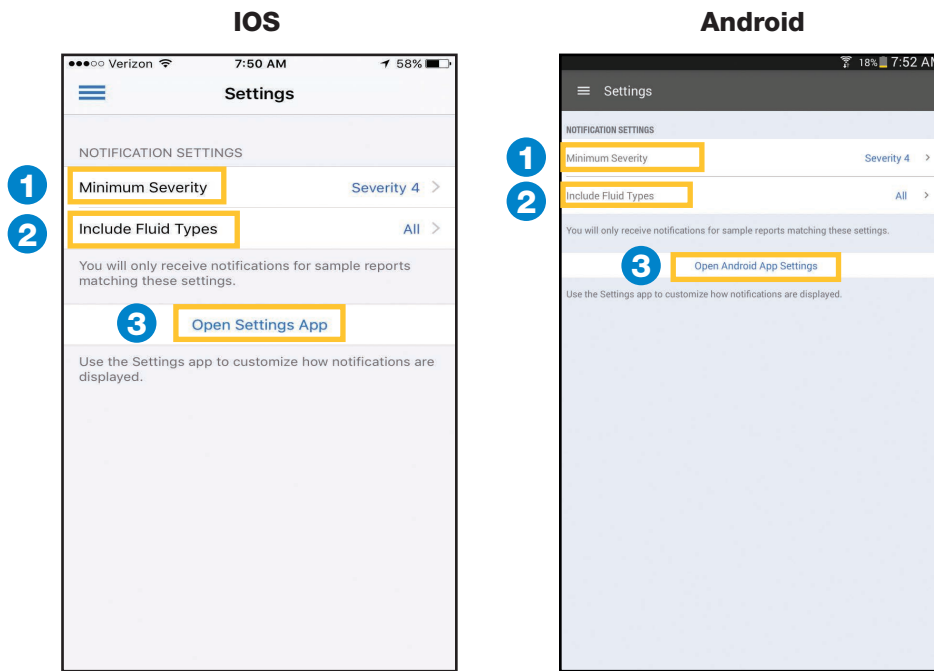


Data analysis experts review test results and send out sample reports around the clock during the normal work week, and the HORIZON app delivers the reports as soon as they are complete. This means the visual and audible “push” notifications can occur at all hours of the day and disturb some users. Use the steps below to manage your HORIZON app settings and receive the right kind of notifications at the time you want them.

Customize alerts by sample type (oil, coolant, or fuel) and by severity level (0 through 4).



- 1 Select the lowest result severity to trigger a notification
- 2 Remove unwanted fluid types
- 3 Adjust mobile device permissions

The easiest way to prevent notifications during evening and sleeping hours is to disable the mobile device’s alert settings during those times. “Do not disturb” and similar features vary by device, manufacturer, and operating system, and a company’s IT department is the best group to help program a mobile device.
